Membership Chair Elaine Guscar said membership dues can be paid now. Please make sure that you dues are paid by January.



A BIG ROUND OF APPLAUSE to those 11 Families who have renewed Membership for 2024!!


My hope is to at least DOUBLE that count by the November meeting, leaving more of us to turn our attention to more important issues... like what stuffing to use for that TURKEY this year.


