

The Big Train Project Status Report (Part 176 – 2023 Christmas Layout)

The Halloween and Christmas holidays are the busiest time of the year for EnterTRAinment Junction (EJ). To provide visitors with added incentives to come, EJ sets up special attractions prior to Halloween and prior to Christmas in its Display Area. One of the biggest challenges for the EJ employees and volunteers is the change-over from the Halloween walk-through display to the Christmas displays. Each year, the G-gauge layout is the centerpiece and most complex part of the Christmas displays. In the past, this layout had been built from scratch, taking a lot of time and manpower to construct in the time between Halloween and the opening of Christmas at the Junction in mid- November. To reduce that time and effort this year, the layout structure was constructed in advance of modular pieces, which could be much more quickly assembled like a kit. Figure 1 shows

the assembled structure.
